Summarizing

General Guidelines

- 1. Begin by reading OR listening to the text selection.
- 2. Follow framework questions:
 - What are the main ideas?
 - What are the crucial details necessary for supporting the ideas?
 - What information is irrelevant or unnecessary?
- 3. Use key words or phrases to identify the main points from the text.

Nonfiction

- 1. Skim the text to get a general idea of the topic
- 2. Delete unnecessary or redundant material
- 3. Find the <u>main ideas</u> in the text
- 4. Find or create a topic sentence
- 5. Substitute general or "umbrella" terms when appropriate (for example, *trees* instead of *oak*, *maple*, and *pine*)

Ask questions:

- 6. What happened?
- 7. Who was involved?
- 8. What was the outcome?
- 9. Is the essential piece of information included?
- 10. Are interesting but nonessential facts or details eliminated?
- 11. Would someone who read my summary really understand the main points of the text?
