UPT STUDENT TRANSPORTATION POLICY

UPT offers transportation to students who participate in the University bus service through the Pittsburgh campus at most University breaks. Students must make a reservation and pay for the shuttle service at least one week in advance of the departure date with the Director of Athletics and Student Union in SU 231. The price of the bus ticket from Pittsburgh to the student's final destination varies.

Transportation is also provided to the Erie International Airport for these breaks. Students must make their own airline arrangements if utilizing this service and arrange for transportation with the Director of Athletics and Student Union in SU 231 at least one week in advance of the transportation need.

Transportation will only be provided to the Pittsburgh campus, the Erie International Airport, and Erie Greyhound Station at:

- **Thanksgiving Break** (departing UPT the Tuesday morning prior to Thanksgiving and returning Sunday evening of Thanksgiving weekend)
- **December Semester Break** (departing UPT the Friday morning of final exams week and returning the day before classes begin in January)
- **Spring Break** (departing UPT the Friday morning Spring Break begins and returning the Sunday evening before classes resume).

Local transportation is available via the CATA Bus, a city bus service for the public. Hours of operation are Monday-Friday, 7:30am-5:30pm, and Saturdays, from 9:00am-4:00pm. UPT students can ride the CATA Bus free of charge.
