Summer Housing

Currently enrolled students can receive a free double occupancy room this summer while enrolled for at least three credits at Pitt-Titusville. Important information to know before signing up for summer housing:

- Meal plans are not available in the summer on campus.
- Students are required to enroll in a minimum of three credits, whether in class, online, or an internship.
- All students participating in an internship lasting beyond August 3rd must find other housing accommodations after that date.
- Offer applies only to the time when the session is in progress.
- Students are not allowed to move-in early or stay after their session.
- Students must move out of their room within 24 hours of the last day of classes for that session.
- The University does not store belongings between terms (spring to summer and summer to fall).
- Students falling below three credits or failing a course will be billed the full room amount.
- Offer does not apply to first-time freshmen or new transfer students.
