Welcome to Pitt-Titusville

The Pitt-Titusville Associate of Science in Nursing program will provide you with all of the tools you need to begin your exciting career in nursing.

Pitt-Titusville will prepare you to sit for the State Board of Nursing examination to become a registered nurse. This program maintains the University of Pittsburgh's emphasis on excellence in education by providing a strong foundation in the sciences and clinical knowledge.

Basic Entry Requirements for High School Applicants

High school or GED scores with a minimum of 16 units, including biology and chemistry with labs.

- Minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 2.75.
- The Pitt-Titusville application process is test optional (SAT/ACT) for new students for Fall of 2024. If you wish, you can submit your SAT/ACT test scores for review; however, only test scores that benefit a student will factor into our decision-making process.
- In addition to academic requirements for admission, program participation requires unencumbered background checks, health verification, HIPAA training, and proof of health insurance.

Basic Entry Requirements for Transfer Applicants

Students transferring from another college or university must have completed a minimum of 12 college-level credits with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75.

Our partnership with the Northern Pennsylvania Regional College (NPRC) will give you the means to meet the requirements for entry into the Associate of Science in Nursing program at Pitt-Titusville.

Utilizing both in-person courses, as well as technology to connect students in classrooms throughout northwestern Pennsylvania, NPRC's programs are designed with your success in mind.

Employment Opportunities for Registered Nurses

Our Associate of Science in Nursing program will prepare you for the examination required for state licensure as a registered nurse.

- Employment of registered nurses is projected to grow 15% through 2026. Additionally, overall employment of nurse anesthetists, nurse midwives, and nurse practitioners is projected to grow 45% through 2030, much faster than the average for all occupations, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor, Occupational Outlook Handbook.
- The annual average wage for registered nurses in Pennsylvania was \$80,630 in May 2022, according to the State Occupational Employment and Wage Estimates Pennsylvania (\$38.76 average hourly wage).
